- "The Environment Is Everything: Where We Live, Work, Play, Go To School, As Well As The Physical And Natural World." *Dr. Robert Bullard*



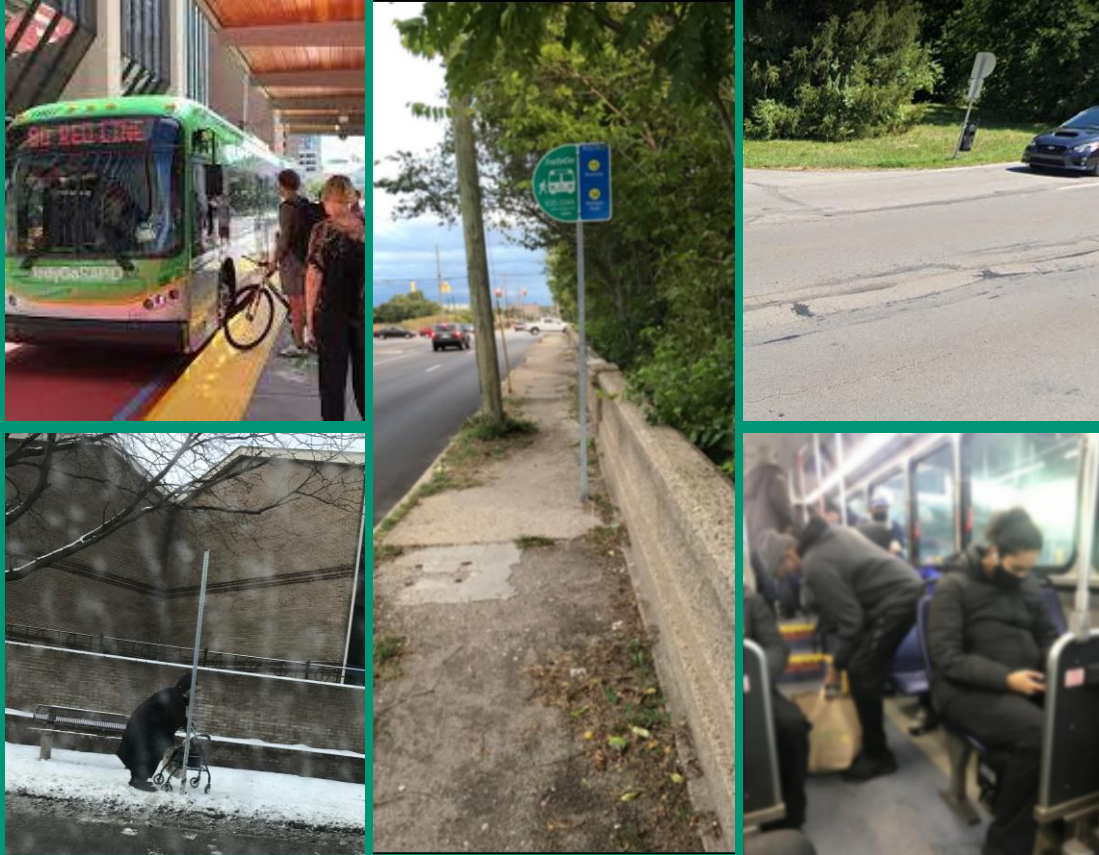
